**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER PCG NO. 42, SERIES OF 2019,
REORGANIZING THE LOCAL COMMITTEE ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE
AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC) OF THE CITY OF PASIG**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Acts (RA) Nos. 9208 and 9262, Inter-Agency Councils (IACs) against human trafficking and violence against women and their children (VAWC) were organized at the national level to address problems on human trafficking and VAWC, and to serve as coordinating and monitoring bodies on anti-trafficking and anti-VAWC initiatives underscores the commitment of the State on safeguarding the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect on their human rights and to protect them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security;

WHEREAS, the Pasig Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children (PCAT-VAWC) was re-constituted through Executive Order No. PCG-42, s. 2019, to monitor and oversee the implementation of the provisions of RA Nos. 9208 and 9262 and other women/VAW-related laws and policies at the local level;

WHEREAS, in the First Quarter Meeting of the PCAT-VAWC held on 07 March 2022, the body recommended that the PCAT-VAWC be re-organized to include additional members;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, City Mayor of Pasig, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, and upon the recommendation of the PCAT-VAWC, do hereby re-organize said Committee as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment to the Reorganization and Composition of the Pasig Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence Against Women and Children. – Sections 1 and 4 of Executive Order PCG No. 42, Series of 2019, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 1. Reorganization and Composition of the Pasig Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence Against Women and Children. – The PCAT-VAWC is hereby reorganized, and shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson : City Mayor
Members : City Planning and Development Coordinator
City Social Welfare and Development Officer
City Health Officer
Sangguniang Panlungsod Chairperson of the
Committee on Women, Children and Family
City Public Employment Services Officer
City Prosecutor
City Director, DILG
Chief of Police, PNP Pasig Central Police Station

Representative, Gender and Development (GAD) Office

Representative, Bahay Kalinga ng Pasigueña (BKP)

Representative, City Budget Office

Representative, City Accounting Office

Representative, Pasig City Local Council of Women

Representative from One Faith-based Organization

NGO Representatives of the following sectors:

1. Women Empowerment Group of Kalawaan
2. Child Representative
3. Overseas Family Circle Pasig Chapter, Inc.

“Section 4. PCAT-VAWC Secretariat. The Secretariat of the PCAT-VAWC shall be the City Social Welfare and Development Office.

As the main administrative support, the Secretariat shall:

1. Organize and make all necessary arrangement for the PCAT-VAWC meetings;
2. Attend and document PCAT-VAWC meetings and proceedings;
3. Prepare the minutes of meeting, draft resolutions, recommendations, communications, and reports;
4. Serve and follow-up resolutions, recommendations and communications of the PCAT-VAWC to concerned individuals, offices, agencies and other entities, and report the result to the Committee during meetings;
5. Monitor PCAT-VAWC activities and milestones for proper reporting to relevant agencies when required;
6. Be the central channel or communications for the PCAT-VAWC and the central depository of all PCAT-VAWC-related information and reports; and,
7. Provide such other assistance as may be required by the PCAT-VAWC.”

SECTION 2. Repealing Clause. All executive issuances inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. Effectivity. – This Order shall take effect immediately upon approval.
