

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. PCG-<u>25</u> SERIES OF 2022

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER EXTENDING ALERT LEVEL 1 FROM 16 JULY TO 31 JULY 2022

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), since having been declared as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), has irreversibly affected millions of lives and families worldwide. Its unprecedented speed of transmission and infectivity has placed a huge burden on essential area of governance, most importantly in vulnerable sectors such as the economy, education, and healthcare;

WHEREAS, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among its constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 2 (b) of Executive Order No. 168 (s.2014) mandates the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) to prevent and/or minimize the entry of suspected or confirmed patients with emerging infectious diseases into the country;

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2021, the President issued Proclamation No. 1218 (s. 2021) further extending the period of the State of Calamity throughout the Philippines until September 12, 2022, unless earlier lifted or extended as circumstances may warrant;

WHEREAS, in an announcement by Presidential Spokesperson Atty. Trixie Cruz – Angeles, Alert Level 1 in the National Capital Region (NCR) shall be maintained, subject to review by the IATF, from 16 July 2022 until 31 July 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, Mayor of Pasig City, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. ALERT LEVEL SYSTEM 1. – The City Government of Pasig maintains the guidelines extending Alert Level System 1 in the National Capital Region.

SECTION 2. DURATION OF ALERT LEVEL SYSTEM 1. – Alert Level System 1 is hereby extended from 16 July 2022 to 31 July 2022, which shall be subject to amendments, if any.

SECTION 3. CONTINUED EFFECTIVITY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT POLICIES. – All COVID-19 related issuances, executive orders, and policies of the City Government of Pasig, insofar as they are not in contradiction to the mandates this Executive Order or of the national government, such as allowed activities and allowed individual movements, shall continue to subsist, and be implemented with full effect. The force and effectivity of the same will be without prejudice to any further changes in the mandates of the local or national government.



SECTION 4. DISSEMINATION. – Copies of this Executive Order shall be furnished within seventy-two (72) hours from its issuance to the Office of the President and the Department of Health for their information and guidance.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval and shall remain in effect for the entirety of Alert Level Systems 1.
